The contemporary Madrid with areas such as Gran Vía, Castellana, the district of Salamanca, Plaza Castilla and Parque del Oeste, as well as commercial and financial areas of Modern Madrid, the emblematic Las Ventas Bullring and the Santiago Bernabéu Football Stadium. The afternoon is free at leisure to continue exploring the wonders that the city has to offer on your own. Tonight join your fellow travellers for an authentic Welcome Tapas Dinner at a local restaurant.

Porto - Coimbra - Fátima

After breakfast, depart for Coimbra, one of the oldest Universities in Europe and the birthplace of Fado. Enjoy some free time before continuing onto Fátima, which is the centre of the Christian Faith and World Pilgrimage Sanctuary with its impressive Basilica and the Cova da Iria Place where the Virgin Mary appeared. See the Chapel of the Apparitions, heart of the sanctuary, with the Tombs of the Three Shepherds, Lucia, Francisco and Jacinta. Tonight, there is the possibility to attend the Procession of the Candles.

Day 7

Fátima - Batalha - Nazaré - Alcobaça - Lisbon

Breakfast at the hotel. Departure for the Batalha Monastery, a masterpiece of Gothic and Manueline style considered a World Heritage Place by UNESCO. Continue to the picturesque fishing town of Nazaré. Enjoy some free time and continue to Alcobaça (World Heritage) with its Gothic Church and Cistercian Monastery, whose origins date back to the XII Century. Continue to Lisbon for your overnight stay.

Lisbon

After breakfast, join a morning city sightseeing of the ancient Olissipo. Drive through its main squares and avenues, see Belem Tower, Jeronimos Monastery, Coach Museum, the Monument to the Discoverers, Marquis of Pombal Square and Liberty Avenue. The afternoon is at leisure for you to catch the nostalgic corners of Alfama Quarter, the Old City gathered next to its Castle, with old buildings nested in narrow twisting 'Ruas' full of colour housing the genuine 'Tabernas'. Tonight, option to join your fellow travellers and enjoy a typical Portuguese dinner visiting one of the oldest Fado venues in the city and located in one of the most interesting cultural neighbourhoods in the area.

Lisbon - Cáceres - Cordoba

Walk through its Plaza Mayor and the Old Town with its famous Medieval Quarter. Then continue towards Cordoba, once the Capital of the Caliphate. Upon arrival, check-in at the hotel. The remainder of the day is at leisure.

This afternoon, is free at leisure to enjoy the city of light on your own.

Continue your journey with an authentic Olive Oil Experience at a local Almazara, LA Organic. Walk through their Olive tree fields and taste their organic Olive Oil production. Then depart for the beautiful Spanish Mediterranean Coastal town of Costa del Sol.

Arrival in Tangier, disembark, clear customs and drive southwards to Casablanca, the current industrial and economic capital and the most populated city housing a 10% of the country population. The remainder of the day is free at leisure. Tonight, enjoy dinner at your hotel.

Day 15

Casablanca - Marrakech

After breakfast at the hotel, enjoy a guided city tour through the most interesting sections of the city, Anfa Boulevard, Nations Square, residential areas and a visit of the outside of the Hassan II Grand Mosque. Depart towards Marrakech, the Capital of the South, located within an extensive oasis between the Atlas Mountains and the pre-desert area. Enjoy a sightseeing tour including the Koutoubia Tower, twin tower of the Giralda in Seville, Saadines Tombs and Bay Palace, walk around the Medina, Souks and the magic Jma El Fna Square, which is packed with fortune tellers, snake tamers, acrobats and dancers, all making the centre of the city an Open-Air Theatre that requires the participation of the audience. Dinner and overnight at the hotel. There is also an Optional dinner and show at Chez Ali Fantasia.

Marrakech - Rabat - Meknes - Fès

After breakfast, depart northeast for Rabat, the diplomatic and administrative capital and official residence of the King Mohamed VI. Enjoy a city tour visiting the important sites such as the Royal Palace from the outside, Mohamed V Mausoleum and the unfinished Hassan Tower, which are important examples of the Almohade architecture. Continue on to Meknes, an Old Walled Imperial City located in the heart of the Mid Atlas. Enjoy a guided tour to admire the great Bab Al Mansour Gate, Morocco's most beautiful gate and the most well known monument in town. Afterwards depart for Fès, the most monumental of the Imperial Cities with its University of 'Karaouyne' being the largest Islamic sanctuary in Morocco. Tonight, enjoy dinner at your hotel.
